GETTING STARTED...

IN A COURSE

Getting started in a course is easy. Here are the steps:

1. Fill out a Registration Form - please scan your BC ID or drivers license and include it with the registration. [Registration Form](#)
2. Go to the courses pages and locate the first assignment (bottom left link) and complete this assignment. Submit it to your instructor (scan or take pictures of it, drop it off at one of our centres etc...)
3. Once your first assignment is received, your instructor will contact you and give you access to the rest of the course. If you do not hear from your instructor in a reasonable length of time (a few days), then please do contact him/her.
4. If you have any questions about a course, please do contact the course instructor!

DO YOU QUALIFY?

The funding formula seems to change every year when it comes to Grade 10-12 courses so please check to make sure that you are eligible for funding for your course!. Courses are funded if:

1. You are a high school aged student - if you do not turn 19 before July 1st then you are eligible to take courses in the upcoming school year starting in September.
2. If you have not graduated with a Grade 12 Dogword or equivalent diploma then you are eligible for funding as long as you taking courses progressing towards graduation no matter what age you are.
3. You must be a resident of BC
4. Grade 10 Foundation courses are free to all including Computer Foundations - Windows 8 and/or iPad

can I still take a course with YouLearn.ca?

Yes. Full-time students are allowed to take extra courses through distributed learning. However, it is important to manage your workload to ensure success.

Only the highest mark for a course appears on your transcript!

No, you can not be enrolled in the same course at two different schools at the same time!

HOW LONG DO I HAVE TO COMPLETE A COURSE?

We encourage students to finish within a calendar year although many students complete their courses quicker.
